**1. A — Adam**

Genesis 2 states God formed Adam from the dust of the ground and breathed life into him.

**2. A — Nazareth**

Jesus was born in Bethlehem of Judea, fulfilling the prophecy of Micah 5:2 about the Messiah's birthplace.

**3. D — 6**

According to Genesis 1, God created the world in six days and rested on the seventh day (Sabbath).

**4. A — Healing a blind man**

At the Wedding at Cana, Jesus turned six stone water jars of water into wine at his mother Mary's request (John 2:1–11).

**5. A — Genesis**

Genesis ('beginning' in Greek) is the first book of the Bible, describing Creation, the Fall, and the patriarchs.

**6. B — not perish but have eternal life**

John 3:16 is called 'the Gospel in a nutshell': 'shall not perish but have eternal life.'

**7. C — Capernaum**

Jesus was born in Bethlehem (Bet Lechem) of Judea, fulfilling the prophecy of Micah 5:2.

**8. B — Goliath**

**9. B — Eve**

Eve (Hava) was created from Adam's rib and is the first woman named in the Bible.

**10. B — Andrew**

John the Baptist baptised Jesus in the Jordan River, after which the Spirit of God descended like a dove (Matthew 3).

**11. A — Apple**

The Bible says 'fruit of the tree of knowledge of good and evil' — never specifying an apple. The apple idea came later in Western tradition.

**12. B — Mount Carmel**

The Sermon on the Mount (Matthew 5–7) was delivered on a mountainside or hillside in Galilee.

**13. B — Hebrews**

The Book of Revelation (Apocalypse of John) is the last book of the New Testament and the entire Bible.

**14. C — Psalm 100**

Psalm 23, the Shepherd Psalm, was written by David and is one of the most beloved passages in the Bible.

**15. D — Nazareth**

Jesus grew up in Nazareth in Galilee, which is why he was called 'Jesus of Nazareth' (Luke 2:51–52).

**16. C — Eve**

**17. C — Noah**

God commanded Noah to build the Ark to save his family and two of every animal from the flood (Genesis 6–9).

**18. C — 12**

Jesus chose 12 apostles (disciples), one for each of the 12 tribes of Israel.

**19. B — God destroyed it with fire**

At Babel, God confused humanity's single language into many, scattering people across the earth so they could not complete the tower (Genesis 11).

**20. C — 3,000**

Jesus fed about 5,000 men (plus women and children) with just five loaves and two fish, with 12 baskets of leftovers (John 6).

**21. C — 63**

The Protestant Bible contains 66 books: 39 in the Old Testament and 27 in the New Testament.

**22. D — Philippians 4:13**

Philippians 4:13 (NIV) is one of the most quoted Bible verses: 'I can do all this through him who gives me strength.'

**23. A — Jerusalem**

Jesus was crucified just outside Jerusalem at Golgotha (also called Calvary).

**24. A — Jesus**

**25. D — Sarah**

Sarai, later renamed Sarah by God, was Abraham's wife and the mother of Isaac.

**26. D — Peter**

Peter (Simon) denied knowing Jesus three times on the night of His arrest, just as Jesus had predicted (Luke 22).

**27. C — 10**

God sent 10 plagues upon Egypt: water to blood, frogs, lice, flies, livestock disease, boils, hail, locusts, darkness, death of firstborn.

**28. D — Isaiah and Jeremiah**

At the Transfiguration, Moses and Elijah appeared with Jesus before Peter, James, and John on the mountain (Matthew 17).

**29. D — 27**

The New Testament has 27 books: 4 Gospels, Acts, 21 Epistles (letters), and Revelation.

**30. A — stars**

Genesis 1:1: 'In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.' — the opening verse of the entire
