1. C — Democratic republic

Article 1: Lithuania is an independent democratic republic.

2. A — Human dignity is inviolable

Article 21: human dignity is protected by law.

3. B — 141

Article 55: the Seimas consists of 141 members.

4. C — 5 years

Article 78: President elected for five years.

5. A — Prime Minister

Article 91: Government headed by Prime Minister.

6. A — 9

Article 103: nine judges.

7. B — Directly by citizens

Article 119: municipal council members are directly elected for four years.

8. A — Proclamation of the Act of Independence in 1918

On February 16, 1918, the Council of Lithuania proclaimed the Act of Independence — the first declaration of independence.

9. A — Klaipėda

Klaipėda is Lithuania's only seaport, located on the Baltic Sea coast.

10. B — The Nation

Article 2: the Nation is sovereign.

11. D — Torture and cruel treatment

Article 21 prohibits torture and cruel treatment.

12. C — 4 years

Seimas members are elected for a four-year term.

13. A — No more than two consecutive terms

Article 78: the same person may not serve more than two consecutive terms.

14. C — President with Seimas approval

Prime Minister appointed by President with Seimas approval.

15. D — 9 years

Article 103: nine years, no second term.

Article 134: the State Controller is appointed for five years.

17. D — Human chain across three Baltic states on August 23, 1989

On August 23, 1989, about 2 million people formed a human chain across all three Baltic states — symbol of peaceful protest for freedom.

18. D — About 65,300 km²

Lithuania covers about 65,300 km² — the largest of the Baltic states.

19. A — Vilnius

Article 13: the capital is Vilnius.

20. B — Only the court

Article 20: liberty can only be restricted by court decision.

21. A — 71

71 from single-member, 70 by proportional representation.

22. D — 40

Article 78: President must be at least 40 years old.

23. D — Implementing laws and state affairs

Government implements laws and manages state affairs.

24. B — Seimas on nomination of President, Speaker, Supreme Court President

Article 103: nominated by President, Speaker, SC President; appointed by Seimas.

25. D — Audit of state property and budget use

Article 133: State Control audits how state institutions use state property and budget funds.

26. B — May 1, 2004

Lithuania joined the EU on May 1, 2004, together with nine other countries.

27. B — UNESCO World Heritage Site between the Curonian Lagoon and Baltic Sea

Curonian Spit is a UNESCO World Heritage Site and national park between the Curonian Lagoon and the Baltic Sea.

28. D — Lithuanian

Article 14: the state language is Lithuanian.

29. C — Presumed innocent until proven guilty

Article 31: a person is presumed innocent until proved guilty by a court judgment.

30. D — Mar 10
