The anthem was composed by Kārlis Baumanis.

2. A — Formation of Livonia, consolidation, Christianization

Consequences: formation of Livonia, ethnic consolidation, Christianization.

3. B — November 18, 1918

Independent Latvia was proclaimed on November 18, 1918.

4. D — Lāčplis

The Latvian national epic is 'Lāčplis'.

According to the Constitution, sovereign state power in Latvia resides with the people.

6. A — Dievs, svētī Latviju

The first words of the Latvian anthem are 'Dievs, svētī Latviju!' (God, bless Latvia!).
