1. A — Paris

Paris has been the capital of France since the 10th century and is home to the Eiffel Tower.

2. D — Tokyo

Tokyo is Japan's capital and the world's most populous metropolitan area.

3. A — Canada

Canada's flag, adopted in 1965, features a red maple leaf on a white background between two red stripes.

4. A — Paris

The Eiffel Tower was built for the 1889 World's Fair in Paris, France, designed by Gustave Eiffel.

5. A — Mount Everest

Mount Everest, on the Nepal–China border, is 8,848.86 m (29,031.7 ft) — the highest point on Earth.

6. C — 7

Earth has 7 continents: Africa, Antarctica, Asia, Australia (Oceania), Europe, North America, and South America.

7. A — Lakshadweep

Sri Lanka (formerly Ceylon) is the large island nation located just south of India across the Palk Strait.

8. A — Israel

9. B — Berlin

Berlin became the capital of reunified Germany in 1990 after the fall of the Berlin Wall.

10. A — Beijing

Beijing (Peking) has been China's capital for most of the last 600 years.

11. B — Switzerland

Switzerland's flag, one of only two square national flags, has a white cross on a red background.

12. B — Rome

The Colosseum in Rome, Italy, was completed in 80 AD and could hold 50,000–80,000 spectators.

13. B — China and India

Mount Everest (Sagarmatha/Chomolungma) straddles the border between Nepal and China (Tibet).

14. D — Asia

Asia covers about 44.6 million km² — roughly 30% of Earth's total land area — making it the largest continent.

15. B — South Korea

Japan (Nihon/Nippon) means 'origin of the sun' in Japanese, earning the nickname 'Land of the Rising Sun'.

16. A — Denmark

Denmark's flag (Dannebrog) features a white cross on a red background. Switzerland's flag is the reverse: a red cross on white.

17. C — Rome

Rome, the Eternal City, has been Italy's capital since 1871 and was the centre of the ancient Roman Empire.

18. B — Kolkata

New Delhi is India's capital, built in the early 20th century adjacent to the historic city of Delhi.

19. C — Bangladesh

Nepal's flag is the only non-rectangular national flag — it is double-pennant shaped (two stacked triangles).

20. C — Nepal

The Taj Mahal is in Agra, India, built by Mughal Emperor Shah Jahan in memory of his wife Mumtaz Mahal.

21. C — Makalu

K2, on the Pakistan–China border, is 8,611 m (28,251 ft) — the second-highest peak and known for difficulty.

22. A — South America

Australia (sometimes called the Australian continent or Oceania) is the smallest of the 7 continents by land area.

23. C — Kamchatka Peninsula

The Indochina Peninsula (Southeast Asian Mainland) comprises Myanmar, Thailand, Laos, Vietnam, and Cambodia.

24. A — South Korea

25. D — Madrid

Madrid, located in the centre of the Iberian Peninsula, has been Spain's capital since the 16th century.

26. C — Yekaterinburg

Moscow (Moskva) is Russia's capital and largest city, home to the Kremlin and Red Square.

27. D — Singapore

Japan's flag (Hinomaru) features a red disc representing the sun on a white background.

28. D — Northern border

The Great Wall runs along China's northern border to protect against nomadic invasions, stretching over 21,000 km.

29. D — Rwenzori

Kilimanjaro in Tanzania, at 5,895 m (19,341 ft), is Africa's highest peak and the world's tallest free-standing mountain.

30. B — Atlantic

The Pacific Ocean covers more than 165 million km² — larger than all of Earth's land combined — making it the largest ocean.
